Fall Native Plant Sale

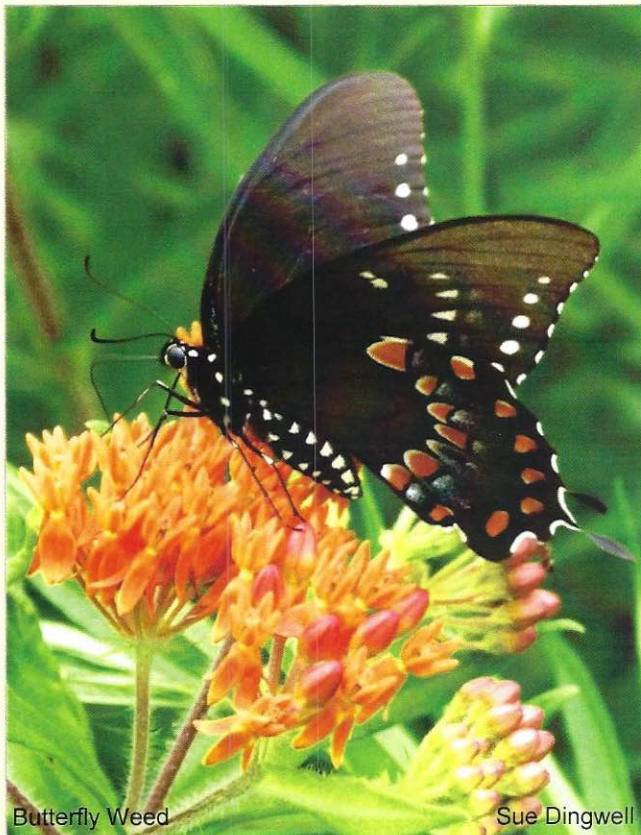
